Allied Health Professions Australia (AHPA) is the peak body and national voice for allied health professions. Allied health professionals are tertiary-qualified health professionals who together make up almost a third of Australia's health workforce but also have important roles in disability, aged care, social services, education and justice.

In addition to our work with our allied health members, AHPA also supports our affiliate organisations. These are associations that represent:

- Allied health professionals with expertise in a specific discipline or modality of practice
- Emerging professions which are working towards recognition based on the criteria for allied health
- Groups which are otherwise aligned with allied health
